



Safeguarding including MCA & DOLS

Our course is aimed towards providing staff with a working knowledge of the processes involved in the safeguarding of vulnerable adults in line with regulations. It also looks at the requirements of Mental Capacity Act and Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards.

Key components include:

- Introduction into safeguarding procedures
- DBS Checks
- Different kinds of abuse the signs and symptoms
- Legislation
- Reporting procedure
- Recording and documenting
- Whistle Blowing.
- MCA & DOLS

Learners are encouraged to share their existing knowledge of Safeguarding procedures and a brief overview is given on the Disclosure and Barring Service, why it is in place and the need for stringent selection and recruitment practices. This will be followed by an in depth review of safeguarding practices and procedures including The Mental Capacity Act and Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards.

At the close of the session learners will complete a short written assessment to confirm that learning has taken place.
